Patricia (Tricia) Ann Bays, 73, of Summerville, passed away Tuesday, February 7, 2023, in her home surrounded by her loving family after a long brave fight with health complications.

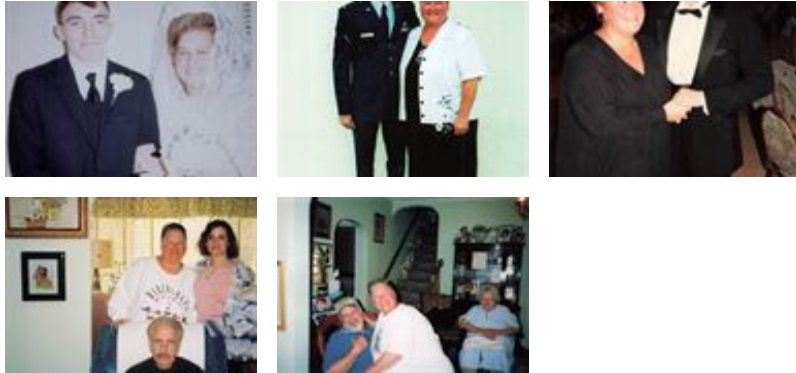
