Paul Andrew Jackson, passed away unexpectedly, at his home, in Summerville, SC and entered eternity on July 15th, 2023.

Paul was born in Hendersonville, NC, August 28th, 1989, the 4th child of 11 children born to Merritt Rickman (Rick) and Catherine (Cathy) Marie Jackson.

He earned the rank of Captain and resigned his commission in 2017, with an Honorable Discharge. He was awarded the Navy/Marine Corps Achievement Medal, the National Defense Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal.

Paul had an infectious smile and a boisterous laugh. He loved to tell jokes and funny stories and would easily make himself laugh. He was a friend to many and made new

friends easily. He loved to discuss issues of life, his God, his family, his country, the Marine Corps, and anything political. He was passionate about many things, none more so than his daughters.

He loved to hunt and fish, but he was most happy anywhere near the water. He was an outdoor enthusiast from early childhood and loved any outdoor adventure. He was a hard worker, wanting to work with his father from the time he could walk. He asked for a weed-eater for his 7th birthday and a lawn mower for his 10th birthday. His hard work and determination served him well at the Citadel and the Marine Corps.
