Reginald J. Fadden, 73, of Summerville, SC, passed away on Sunday, May 4th, 2025.

Reginald was born on October 19th, 1951, in Camp Lejeune, NC, a son of the late Reginald J. Fadden, Sr. and Edna Stevens Fadden. Reginald was a graduate of the United States Military Academy, West Point, earning a Bachelor of Science degree, and in 1974 was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant in the US Army. He dedicated 31 years of his life to serving the US Army, retiring as a Lt Colonel. Reginald's US Army service involved being an Army Ranger and Pilot. He married the love of his life, Kathleen Jones Fadden, and they spent 50 years together. He had many enjoyments in life including hunting, specifically in Maine, traveling, watching West Point Football and Academy Athletics and most of all, spending time with his beloved family.

He is survived by his loving wife, Kathleen Fadden; his children: Reginald J. Fadden, III (Machiko) and Meredith Knight (Hugh); his grandchildren: Luke H.

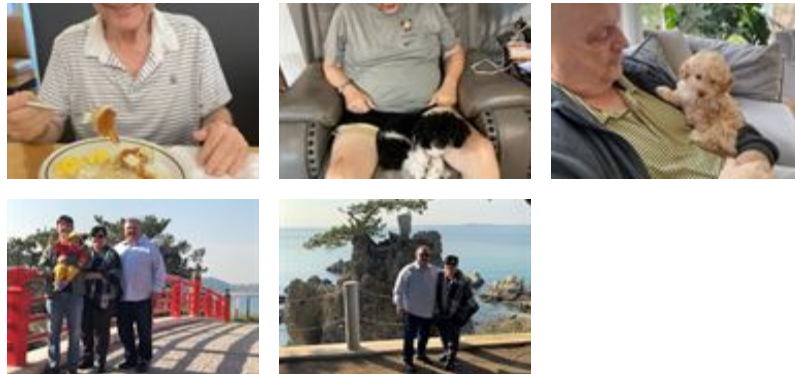
