QMC Reid Gardner Cayce, USN (Ret.) 95, of Summerville, Widower of Marian Virginia Cayce died Saturday, December 22, 2018 at Veterans Victory House.

Hill of Eutawville; seven grandchildren; and three great grandchildren. He was predeceased by two brothers: William R. Cayce and Robert B. Cayce; three sisters: Ruth C. Denton, Elizabeth C. 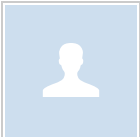
