Robert "Bob" Charles Marriott, 73, of Summerville, husband of Donna Steinkamp Marriott, passed away on Friday, July 30, 2021 at Summerville Medical Center.

He was a huge Dolphins and Red Sox fan. He always helped others. Above all Bob loved spending time with his grandchildren.
