Robert Eugene Duckworth, 52, of Goose Creek, SC passed away on Saturday, May 17th, 2025.

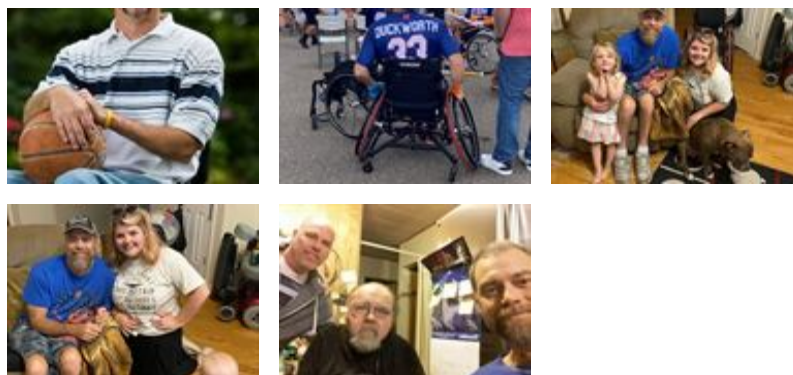
