An American hero passed away today. Robert James Mitchell passed on Friday, 3 January, 2014. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Joan Mitchell and daughter, Carol.

Known to his friends as Bob, he was eager to join the Army before his 18th birthday. Not allowed in before, he joined the very day of his 18th birthday. From there he saw actions in major battles including Ardennes, Central Europe, Normandy, Northern France and Rhineland. Trained as a Radio Operator, he fought at the Battle of the Bulge. SSgt. Mitchell was presented many awards including the Bronze Star. A lifelong patriot, upon retirement he served as Chaplain and President of the SC Chapter of the Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge.

His love of his life was Joan Elizabeth Boon to whom he was married for 45 years. Their great union resulted in a family of five children: Carol, Mike,

Bobby, Peter and Brian. He has numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.

After the military he ran his own business called Bob's Pest Control. His many passions included Jazz, the Minnesota Vikings and all things American. He was a devout Catholic.
