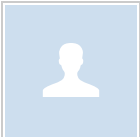

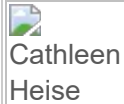

Roberta was a paragon of Respiratory Therapy and some of the best days of my Nursing were when She and Jenny (the other half of the Dynamic Duo) stopped by each morning and let me know who was where and WHAT was WHAT! Nursing cannot ask for more then that!

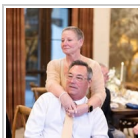
