Sadie Louise Hamilton Call, widow of Robert W. Call (USAF, RET), peacefully went home to meet her Lord on November 27, 2021, after a brief illness. A daughter of Maxie and Sadie Hamilton, she was born 7/31/1931 in Grand Bay, AL. She graduated from business college in Mobile, AL, where she met and married her husband of over 65 years, Bob. They started their family in Mobile before a brief tour of duty in Washington, DC, where the family continued to grow. In 1955, they moved to Summerville, SC, where they put down deep family roots and completed their family. Louise enjoyed a stellar 30 year career of civil service on Charleston Air Force Base, where in 1991 she retired as Executive Secretary to the Wing Commander. Retirement afforded her the opportunity to travel extensively, pursue her talents in crafts, and fulfill her passions for missions, family, and friends. Louise faced death as she did life with her signature faith, grace, and dignity.
