She was active in the Women's Missionary Union and had also joined in a mission trip to Brazil. She also served as an officer in the Jessamine Chapter of the American Business Women's Association. After

retirement and the death of her husband, while living in Simpsonville, SC, she worked seasonally at Greenville Technical College bookstore and also volunteered at Hillcrest Memorial Hospital. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister and aunt whose greatest joys came from serving her Lord and being with family, friends and her church fellowship. She also found satisfaction in cooking and sharing a special dish, as well as keeping a beautiful yard and flower garden.
