Timothy (Tim) Joseph Crowley, 70, of Pittsburgh, PA, passed away on October 12, 2023, in Goose Creek, SC. Tim was born on June 18, 1953, in Pittsburgh, PA. He attended St Mary of the Mount Grade and High School, where he played basketball in the Catholic B league throughout his high school years. 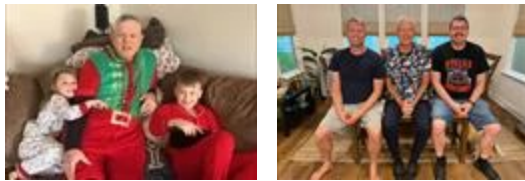
