Col. Tommy Dell Marlatt, 84, of Summerville, husband of Deborah Wilcox Marlatt, passed away on Thursday, March 14, 2013 at his residence.

A gathering of friends and family will be held on Thursday, March 21, 2013 at James A. Dyal Funeral Home from 6 o'clock until hour of service. A memorial service will begin at 7 o'clock PM. Burial will be held at Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.
