Virgie L. Horne, 78, of Summerville, widow of CMSg. Frank Horne (USAF), passed away on September 28, 2018 at Life Care Center of Charleston, after a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease.

Mrs. Horne was born on February 9, 1940, in Buffalo, SC, to the late Kathleen Boulware Fisher and James Dallas Fisher. She was a 1958 graduate of Union High School. She married Frank Horne and enjoyed being an Air Force wife for fifty-one years until Chief Horne's death in 2011. They enjoyed numerous assignments for the United States Air Force in Savannah, Greenville, Norfolk, and California before Mr. Horne's final duty station at the Charleston Air Force Base where he retired. They enjoyed entertaining the Generals and their wives when they came to Charleston and their favorite song was Frank Sinatra's "My Way". Mrs. Horne retired as executive secretary from Alcoa at Mt.
