Wilfredo Lopez, known to friends as "Fred," passed away on June 3, 2018, at the age of 71 years old.

A native of Bronx, New York, Fred attended Dodge Vocational High School. After graduating, he joined the United States Air Force. He was stationed at the Charleston Air Force Base in Charleston, SC.
