Wilson Kenneth "Ken" Britton II, 47, of Cameron, SC died Wednesday, October 4, 2017, as a result of injuries received in an airplane accident.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, October 9, 2017 at 11 o'clock AM at James A. Dyal Funeral Home. A gathering of friends and family will follow after the service.

Born March 3, 1970, in Charleston, he was the son of Wilson Kenneth Britton and Brenda Branton Britton of Hollywood, SC. He was a 1993 graduate of Clemson University with a BS degree in Wildlife, Fisheries and Biology. He was quarry manager for Argos US in Harleyville. Ken was an avid hunter and loved to be outdoors. 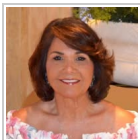
