Woodrow Coffey, Jr, 80, of Summerville, passed away January 13, 2014 at Trident Medical Center where he spent the last two weeks of his life battling lung cancer.

Woodrow was born on September 22, 1933 in Oneida, TN to Woodrow Coffey and Emma West Coffey. He is a veteran of the Korean Conflict Era, the Vietnam Era and Peacetime. He retired from the United States Air Force with 21 years of active duty service. He also retired from the Charleston Air Force Base Civil Service. He was married to his wife, the former Peggy Ann Craynon, also of Oneida, TN.
